Five-Day Face-to-Face AICTE Faculty Development Programme on Universal Human Values (UHV-II)



Day 4 Report

Day 4 of the Faculty Development Programme commenced with an informal sharing session, allowing participants to reflect on their learning journey, followed by a recap of Day 3. The discussions revisited the **four aspects of relationships** and the **programme for their fulfillment**, emphasizing their role in ensuring **mutual happiness**. The sessions reinforced **Trust** and **Respect** as the foundational values of every relationship. Participants explored the meaning of Trust, the distinction between **intention** and **competence**, the true meaning of Respect, the difference between **respect** and **differentiation**, and the significance of other essential values that nurture harmonious relationships.

The second session focused on the other salient values in relationships, namely **Affection, Care, Guidance, Reverence, Glory, Gratitude, and Love**. Through thought-provoking discussions and interactive examples, participants gained a deeper understanding of how these values contribute to harmony within individuals, families, and society.

The programme then progressed to **Understanding Harmony in Society**, presenting society as an extension of the family. Participants explored **Prosperity, Fearlessness (Trust), and Co-existence** as the comprehensive human goals and visualized a **Universal Harmonious Order** through the concepts of **Undivided Society** and **Universal Order**, envisioning the journey from a harmonious family to a harmonious world family.

The day also featured an engaging tutorial session, where participants reflected on relationships within the **family**. Meaningful discussions on **teacher–student relationships**, the **true goal of education**, and real-life experiences encouraged participants to relate the concepts to their personal and professional lives. Among the values discussed, **Gratitude** emerged as a powerful universal value, with many participants sharing inspiring real-life instances that highlighted its transformative impact on relationships.

The interactive sessions, reflective activities, and collaborative discussions enabled participants to internalize the concepts and appreciate the relevance of Universal Human Values in building harmonious relationships at every level—from the individual and the family to society and the entire human order.
