1. REVIEW OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the 35th IQAC meeting were reviewed by the Principal, Dr. K.A. Mohamed Junaid. The members discussed the progress made in academic activities, research initiatives, placement activities, NBA preparation, and student support initiatives implemented after the previous meeting. Dr. Pavai Madheswari, Dean Academics, presented the following:

a. Identification of Honours and Minor Courses in EVEN Semester 2025-26

The departments presented the honours and minor courses identified for the EVEN semester 2025-26. Students were encouraged to enroll in interdisciplinary and advanced courses to enhance their knowledge and employability.

b. Progress of Final Year Student Projects

The progress of final year student projects across all departments was reviewed. Faculty members were advised to ensure timely completion of project reviews and encourage innovative and industry-oriented projects.

c. NPTEL Result Analysis of the Academic Year 2025-26

The NPTEL course result analysis for the academic year 2025-26 was presented. Departments with commendable performance in certification and successful completion percentages were appreciated.

Dr. K.K. Sivagnana Prabhu, Dean CDC, presented the following:

i. Placement

a. Placement Training Programs

Placement training programs conducted for students including aptitude training, coding practice, technical skill development, communication skills, and mock interviews were reviewed.

b. Placement Statistics – 2026 Batch

The placement statistics for the 2026 graduating batch were presented and discussed. Departments were advised to continue placement-focused activities to improve placement performance.

ii. GATE 2026

The initiatives taken for motivating students to appear for GATE 2026 examinations were discussed. Special coaching and guidance activities conducted were reviewed.

iii. Higher Studies Activities

Activities related to higher studies guidance, competitive examination awareness, and overseas education opportunities were discussed. Students were encouraged to pursue higher education in reputed institutions.

6. STUDENT SUPPORT AND PROGRESSION – CLUB ACTIVITIES

Dr. S. Vijayalakshmi, Professor/ECE, presented the activities organized through various student clubs.

- Community engagement programs.

Students were encouraged to actively participate in club activities for holistic development and leadership enhancement.

7. ALUMNI MEET AND ACTIVITIES

Alumni meet was conducted on 12.10.2025. More than 1000 Alumni participated in the Alumni meet. The committee discussed alumni interaction activities conducted during the semester. Alumni contributions towards placement support, guest lectures, internships, and industry interaction were appreciated.

- Organizing department-wise alumni interaction sessions.
- Enhancing alumni support for placements and internships.

8. RANKING AND ACHIEVEMENTS

The Principal, Dr. K.A. Mohamed Junaid, discussed the following:

a. NBA SAR Preparation and Follow-up

The progress of NBA SAR preparation activities was reviewed. Departments were instructed to complete documentation activities and ensure continuous compliance with NBA requirements.

b. NIRF Ranking
