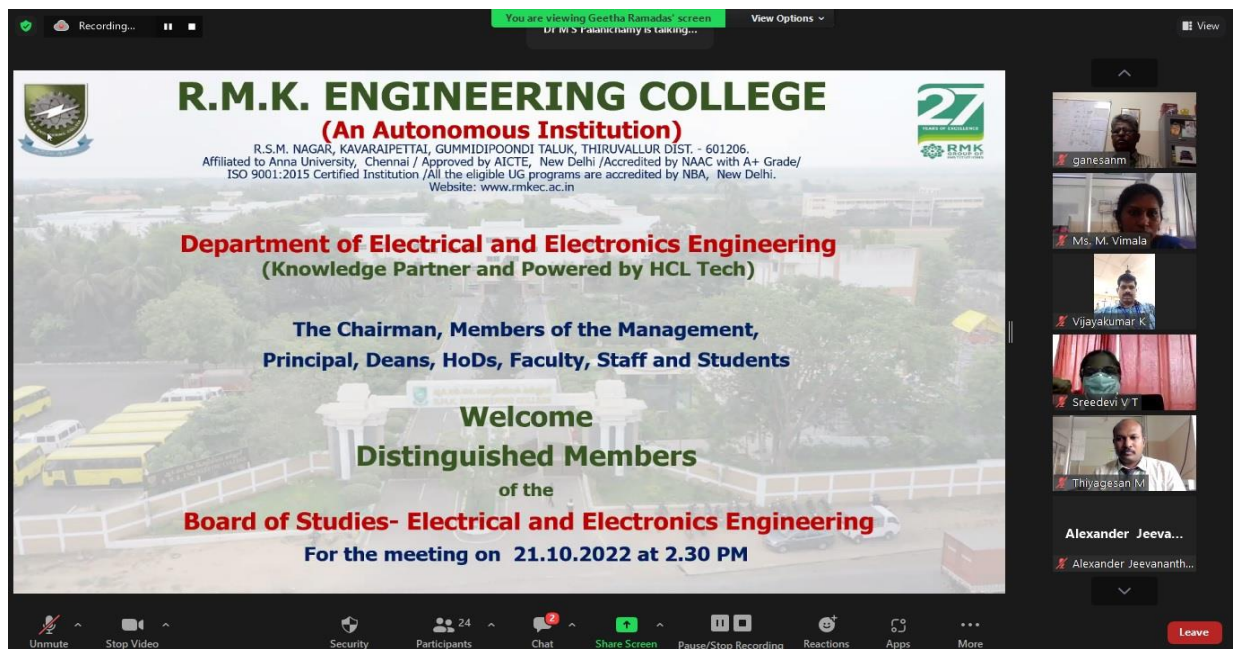
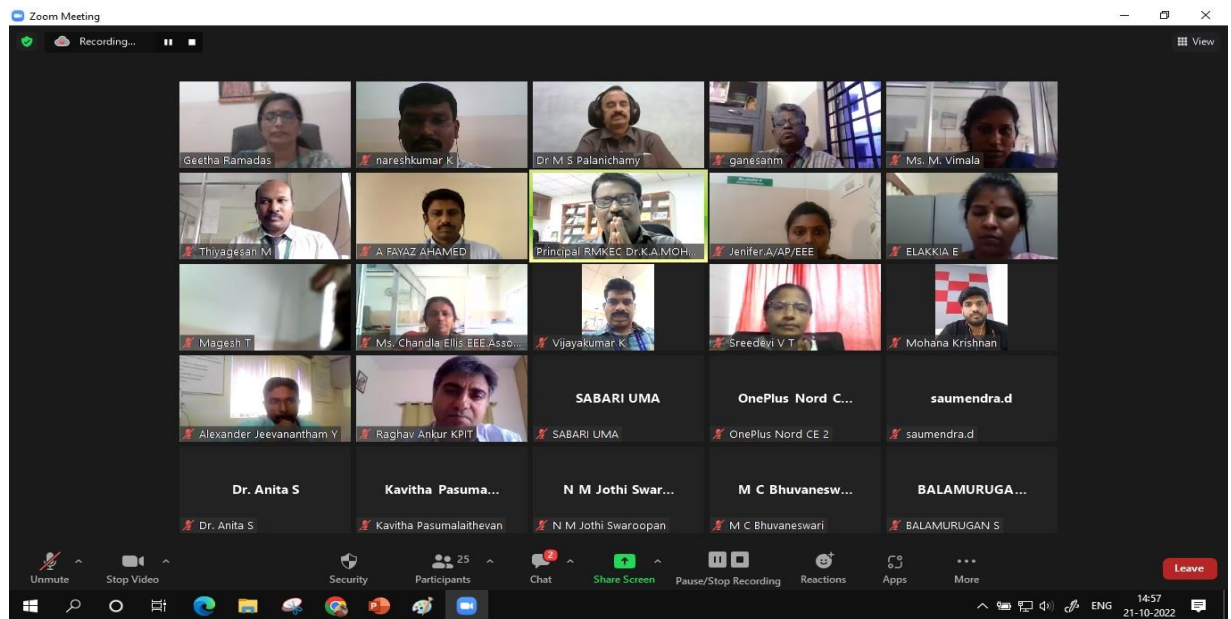
The minutes of the meeting are as follows:

As per the suggestions from Dr. M.C. Bhuvaneswari, Anna University Representative, suggested that Microcontroller and ARM Processor can be shifted from third semester to fourth semester as they are learning Digital Electronics and Analog Electronics during third semester 2. Microcontroller and ARM Processor shifted to fourth semester as per the suggestion. Control systems shifted to third semester, Microprocessors shifted to fifth semester and Digital Signal Processing shifted to fourth semester to accommodate the above change.
